- 2. Secondly, I would like to suggest you to appoint a consultant for complaints about the Sikh community. It is important to appoint an organisation which is involved in all spheres of Sikh community in the UK. I would like to suggest Sikh Press Association as an organisation which can represent my community.
- 3. There have been several instances where my identity as a Sikh has been mistaken by the journalists. There needs to be a robust due diligence. The journalists should be held accountable. For example, Sikh New Year for Visakhi is run every year. I have been living in this for nearly 10 years. Initially, I felt that it maybe the ignorance of the journalists but however over the time in have realised that there are resources which are not validated by the Sikh community being used as a source of information. Your review should take into consideration a must due diligence and most importantly should consult with the modern Sikh groups in the UK.
